### C. Fundraising:

- a. Crab Feed (Feb 24, 2024) \*Veterans Memorial Building (need a Veteran or AC employee for 50% off of hourly facility rate) tour on 09/06/23, pricing provided for possible Crab Feed Location, Pricing on Portuguese Hall Hayward; Boys & Girls Club
  - Crab Feed Exploring Venues, the attendance for the last crab feed was 273. Our goal this year is 200-250 attendees. Capacity at the Veterans Hall is about 300 attendees. The space has a built in bar area and raffle baskets can be merchandised nearby for maximum visibility. We can use our own bar. Boys and Girls Club San Leandro has parking concerns along with needing our own food license. Crab is already cooked, cleaned and prepped, it is a cold crab feed and will include salad and spaghetti in addition to the crab. Portuguese Hall more difficult bar situation. Would need liquor license, additional insurance along with a percentage of sales. Insurance needs to include serving alcohol and additional security.
- b. Car Show (May 11, 2024)
- · Car Show James Reed is the contact, used to help when held in honor or Randy DeVechhi and heads the Grant Avenue Foundation.
- · Working on logistics: participants purchase a spot, school policy for space, getting vendors. Possibly band and food from the community. Need to determine rental charge for a booth/car space; likely \$20-\$30 per space.
- Need to elect a committee. Notes about similar events: Portuguese Hall in Union City working with a car club and was a great way to reach out and get their established group to participate in the event. Also note was the possibility of a Bike Show and working with Sam Medina at the little league field could assist / connect network.
- c. Sell Arroyo Blankets, sweaters, stickers etc. at Sports Events/Games, possibly set up and run snack bar. Submitting letters to local stores for gift cards to buy snack bar supplies.
