- e. Crab Feed; 2/24/24 tentative (waiting for confirmation on winter ball dates). Looked at Portuguese hall in Union City, through Carla and John we can get a reduce rate and the hall will fully host the bar and drinks. We can extend the hours and host a dance after dinner. More time to clean up, less overheard up front and more room for more ticket sales up to 500. Reached out and visited the Portuguese Hall. Can have up to 500 people, \$1500-\$2000 for the venue. We wouldn't be able to have the bar profits, but the overall savings will likely make it an even better profit. Portuguese Hall is showing a lot of benefits compared to what we were receiving from the VH. PH includes upstairs and downstairs and is a very nice venue and is still convenient to our area in Union City. Can host a dance after the dinner. Pre-pay ahead of time, no refunds, cannot buy at the door. Seating needs to be managed, especially for large groups. Waiting to find out when Winter ball is to confirm date as we want to make sure there is enough time between the two events. Tentatively planning to move date to March 16 to reserve at Portuguese Hall.
